SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA



- All applications must be postmarked or hand-delivered by March 1, 2025.
- Applications can be mailed to: SRE Trust Scholarship Fund, P.O. Box 40, Barnesville, GA 30204, or delivered to 1367 Hwy 341 South, Barnesville, GA 30204. Late applications will not be considered.
- The applicant's primary residence must be within Bibb, Coweta*, Crawford, Lamar, Pike, Meriwether, Monroe, Spalding or Upson counties. *Coweta applicants are restricted to the 30229 zip code.
- The applicant must be enrolled, at the time of the award, in an accredited college or technical school program, either full-time or part-time.
- The scholarship is for undergraduate studies only. Applications for master's or doctorate degrees will not be accepted.
- The competition is open to high school students with an acceptance letter and plans to begin college no later than the fall semester after graduation, as well as to current college and technical school students.
- The scholarship funds will be paid directly to the recipient's college, university, or vocational school.
- Applicants may reapply each year, but previous winners are not eligible to win again.
- Five winners will each receive a \$3,000 scholarship.
- Scholarship use must begin within one year of the award date and be fully utilized within two years. Funds will be paid directly to the school.
- A committee of judges will review the applications and make recommendations to the Southern Rivers Energy Trust, which will make the final decision. All decisions are final.
- If you are awarded the scholarship and the photo you submitted with your application is not acceptable for promotional use, you will be asked to submit another one or have one taken at SRE's office before any scholarship funds are released. Please submit a recent school or professional photo (headshot only) for this purpose. No glamour shots, please.
- The Southern Rivers Energy Trust, Inc. administers the scholarship.
- Scholarship winners will be announced in April.

The essay should be **1,000 words or less**, typed and double-spaced.

Do NOT reveal your name, place of residence, school, etc. in the essay, as such references will disqualify your application.

Proofread your essay before submitting your application. Points will be deducted for grammatical errors and misspelled words.

Southern Rivers Energy Scholarship Essay Prompt:

Commitment to Community: Cooperatives, like Southern Rivers Energy, are built on the foundation of community service and collaboration. Describe your commitment to your community, focusing on how you have contributed to the cooperative spirit. Include any school, church, or civic activities where you have given your time or talents to better your community. You may also highlight any work experience that aligns with these cooperative values.

Accountability and Financial Need: Explain how you plan to be accountable with these scholarship funds. Include how this financial assistance will help you achieve your educational goals and what challenges you would face without it. Be specific about your goals and how they reflect the values of responsibility and stewardship, key aspects of the cooperative business model.

Demonstrating Integrity: As a recipient of this scholarship, you would become an unofficial representative of Southern Rivers Energy and the Southern Rivers Energy Trust. What qualities do you possess that demonstrate your commitment to integrity, one of the Touchstone Energy Cooperative values? Reflect on how you embody honesty, accountability, and commitment to your community.
